

SUBJECT: Personalized Race Information: Sept. 19 Log Run Half Marathon

Get set for a Saturday to remember! You're registered for the Log Run Half Marathon on August 8. Please read for important information and changes.

Bib Numbers

You may look up your bib number by last name in notebooks as you enter Packet Pickup.

Please remember, bib numbers are NOT transferrable to another runner under any circumstances. Full Stop. You and the person using your bib number could be subject to penalties. This is for your own safety, the integrity of the event and its results under USA Track & Field course certification rules.

Now, let's get excited for race day!!

Public Lands is located in the Woodbury Lakes shopping area at the intersection of Interstate 94 and Radio Dr. Plenty of parking is available and you can pick up any last-minute items you need for race day!

Changing Distances

You may change your distance at Packet Pickup. *Get your bib first* (obviously) then come to the Changes table to make the switch. Moving up in distance, you pay the difference. There is no charge for moving down in distance. Such a deal!

In-Person Registration and Will Call

Registration is available in-person at Packet Pickup for any procrastinators out there who decide to join you at the last minute. Will Call registration is available *online from 12:01 a.m. September 17 to noon Friday, September 18*. People registering during this time are assigned a bib number **before** Packet Pickup and may look up their number when arriving to get their bib. See the website for details.

Race Day Information

Parking

Downtown Stillwater has ample free parking available west of main street. A map is available [HERE](#) for reference and also includes the locations for Packet Pickup, shuttle loading and the finish line.

No parking is available between Main St. and the river due to event set up for the race and another event happening in the north part of Lowell Park South – the ALZ Ride to End Alzheimer's.

Shuttles to Your Starting Area

6:30 – 7:35 **SHARP**

Heads up; new locale! **Shuttles load on Water Street between Mulberry and Myrtle.**

Buses are marked for each location. Check before you board.

YOU MUST TAKE THE BUS and have your bib with you to board. **NO BIB, NO BUS RIDE.** Exceptions are made only for unregistered parents/guardians accompanying minors on buses prior to the last bus, which may not return downtown.

Start Lines

8:00 a.m.: All distances

Each start location has water, portapotties and bag drop available.

Bag Drop

- Bags for your items are provided at each start location
- Bags are clear and 15" x 18"
- If it fits in the bag, you're good
- **Items not accepted:** backpacks, large purses/totes, suitcases, pets, children...you get the idea. Some exceptions may be made for fresh pastries, hot coffee, omelets and pizza, but expect taxes to be taken in the form of consumption prior to pick-up.
Back to the real stuff...
- Place your bag drop tag **INSIDE** the bag so it is visible
- Your race bib and bag drop tag must match to pick up your items/crumbs
- **KNOT, DON'T JUST CINCH!** Open or loosely closed bags can mean your stuff dumps out and can get separated from the one thing we need to know who it belongs to – your tag
- Bag drop pick-up is at the finish line starting at approximately 8:45 to give us time for sorting
- Run Stillwater, Inc. is not responsible for lost or damaged items left in bag check

Pacers

Pacing for the half marathon is provided by Midwest Pacers. Pacing times are:

1:40
1:50
2:00
2:10
2:20
2:30

Course Information

Aid Stations: Water and Gatorade are available at each aid station. Portapotties are located at approximately every two miles throughout the course.

Half Marathon: The Half course has six aid stations at *approximately* two-mile increments (2, 4, 6, 8, 10 and 12)

10K Race: The 10K course has three aid stations

5K Race: The 5K course has one aid station

Important Info About Your Final Approach

As you get close to the finish, all runners will turn left onto Mulberry Street. Be aware that you'll see a finish line in front of you about two blocks down. THAT IS NOT YOUR FINISH LINE! You're close but still have a ¼ mile or so to go. Marshals will guide you to turn right onto Water Street. You'll make a couple of easy zig zags passing in front of the Water Street Inn then down along the river where you'll see your goal as you pass under the lift bridge and push on to the finish line!

Finish Information

The finish area is located south of the Stillwater Lift Bridge in Lowell Park at the flagpole. Post-race recovery food and liquids for runners include bottled water, Gatorade, bananas, oranges, and salty snacks.

Once you replenish and greet family and friends, take some time to visit our sponsors at the finish line.

Spectators

Friends and family are welcome to cheer you on along the course. Please note:

- Roads are not closed for the race
- Do not block traffic and stay out of roadways
- NEVER park on the coned side of the road blocking runners

Inquire at Packet Pickup for further details if needed. The finish line area has plenty of space and good vantage points to view runners crossing the finish line.

Download Our Tracking App

Run Stillwater offers race results and tracking using our mobile app available in the [Apple App Store](#) and [Google Play](#). Participants are uploaded to the app 2-3 days ahead of the race. Be patient if you don't see your bib number right away.

The app provides live results, allowing participants to see their performance seconds after crossing the finish line. Spectators can track the progress of participants on the course and stay updated via Race

Update notifications, interactive course Maps, and real-time Leaderboards. Download it now and get set up before race day.

Exchanging Shirt Sizes After the Race

Shirt size exchange is located in the same location as Packet Pickup after the race.

In-person and Will Call registrants may pick up their shirts at the same location. We will have your forms and sign-up information. All you need is your bib number to pick up a shirt.

Weather Conditions

As always, we monitor conditions with the National Weather Service and work closely with emergency services and public safety to ensure a safe race. Please take whatever precautions you feel are needed to be prepared for the conditions.

Results

In addition to the smartphone app, race results are available at [Mtec Results](#) and accessible on a smartphone, tablet or computer. A link to results is on the Run Stillwater website, Log Run page.

Age-Group Awards

We will not hold an awards ceremony. Top three finishers in each age category will receive personalized awards mailed after the race to commemorate your accomplishment. Age/gender categories are in 5-year increments (e.g., 5-9, 10-14, 15-19, 20-24, etc.) Awards are personalized with the race logo, your name, place, distance, age group and time. Please allow 3-4 weeks for production and mailing.

Post-Race SHOWERS!

Available after the race at **River Valley Athletic Club** [1826 Northwestern Avenue](#), Stillwater. *Bring your own towel and show your bib*, then get out and enjoy Stillwater!

Photos taken along the course and at the finish are available to download at no charge. In addition, a time clock at the finish will show your name and time to take pictures of your own.
